Speaker of Maharashtra Legislative Assembly, Member of Parliament, Member of Legislative Assembly and leading Industrialists. Many freedom fighters and social reformers have visited the institution which include Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, Sane Guruji etc. The well known historian Babasaheb Purandare stayed at Muktainagar for four days.

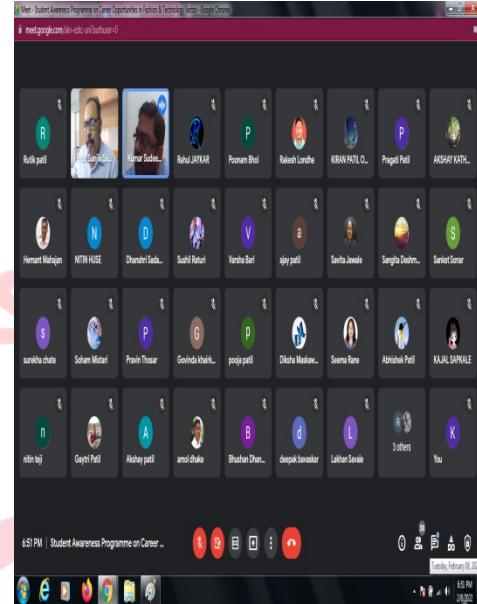
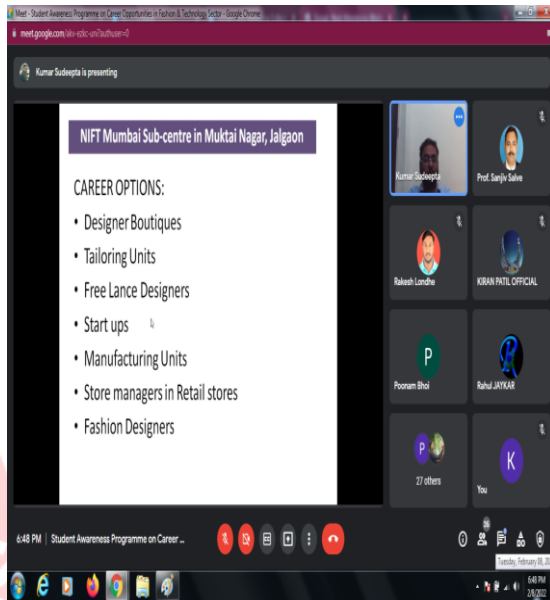

➤ Swayam: A Learner Friendly Platform

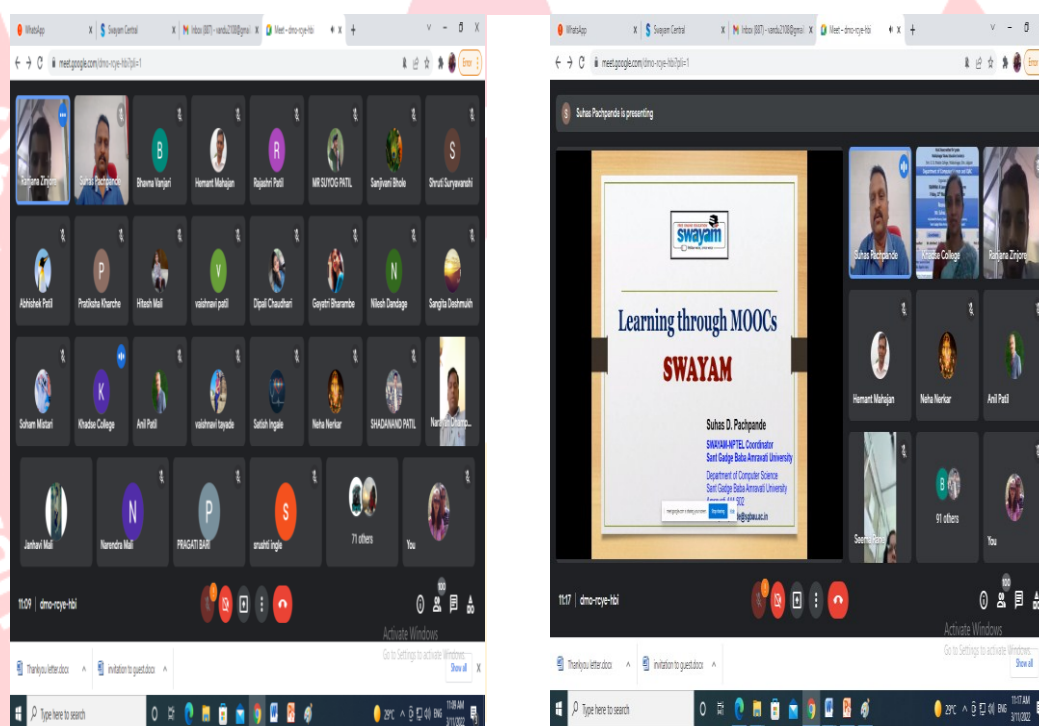
