The EdlabadTaluka Education Society, now known as MuktainagarTaluka Education Society, was established in 1954 with the aim of providing quality education. GadavaribalGanpatraoKhadse Arts, Science, and Commerce College in Muktainagar in 1990. As the field of Electronics, Computer Science, and Information Technology gained prominence, the college introduced courses in Computer Science and Electronics in 1997, followed by B.Sc. IT in 2001.
